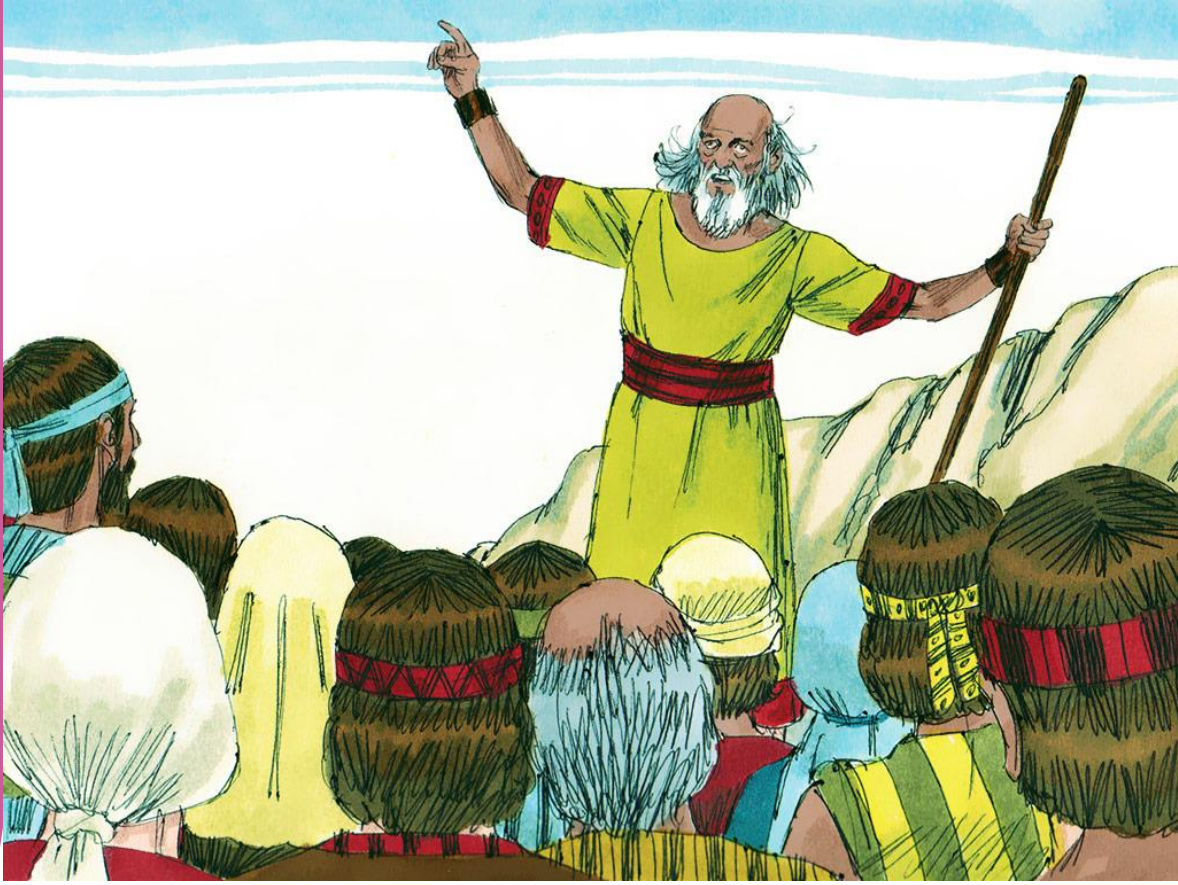




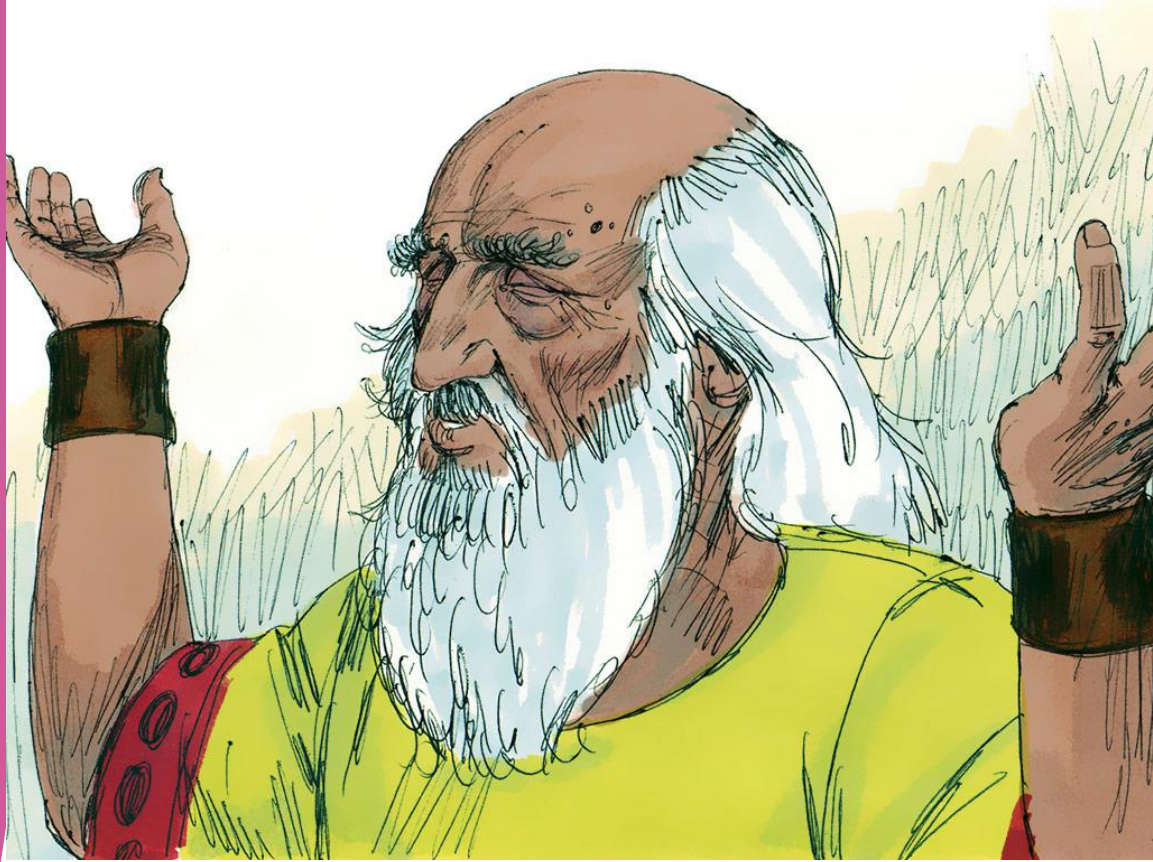
***When Samuel Old.

Joel & Abijah become judges***



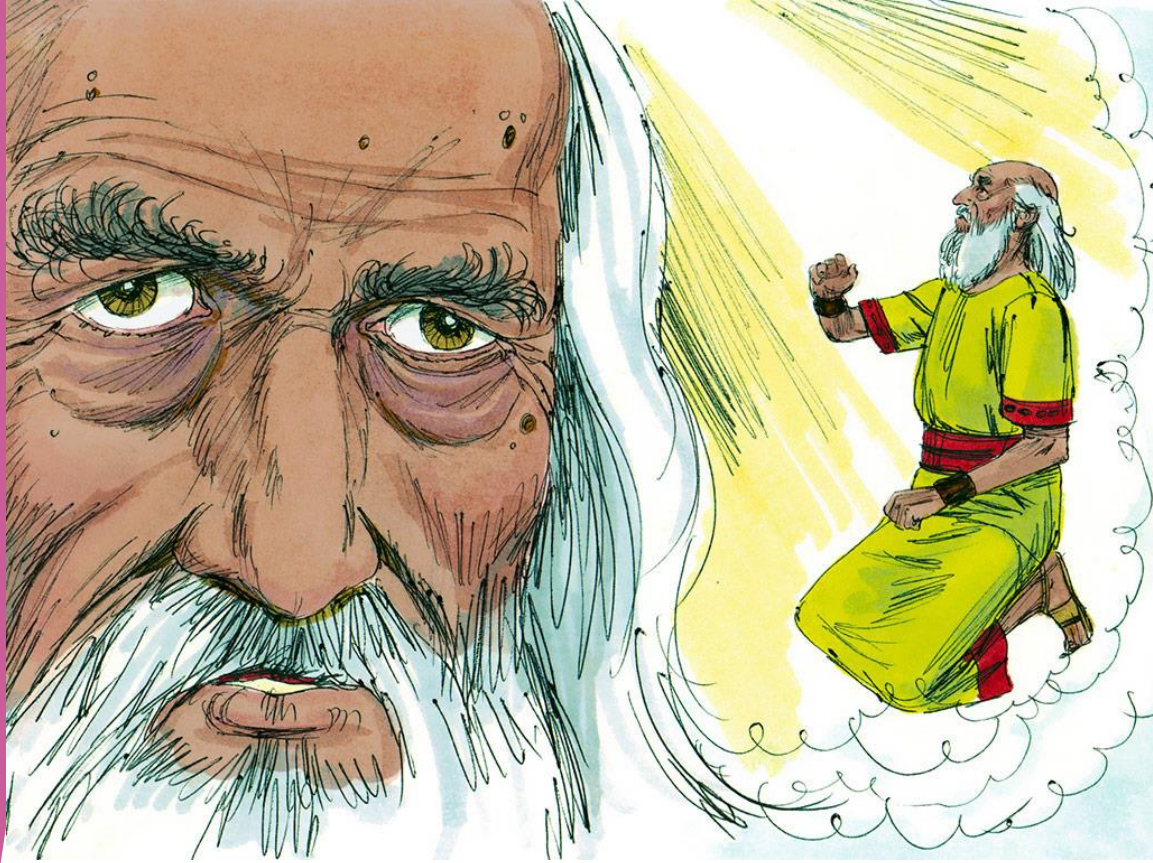
But Israelites requested for King



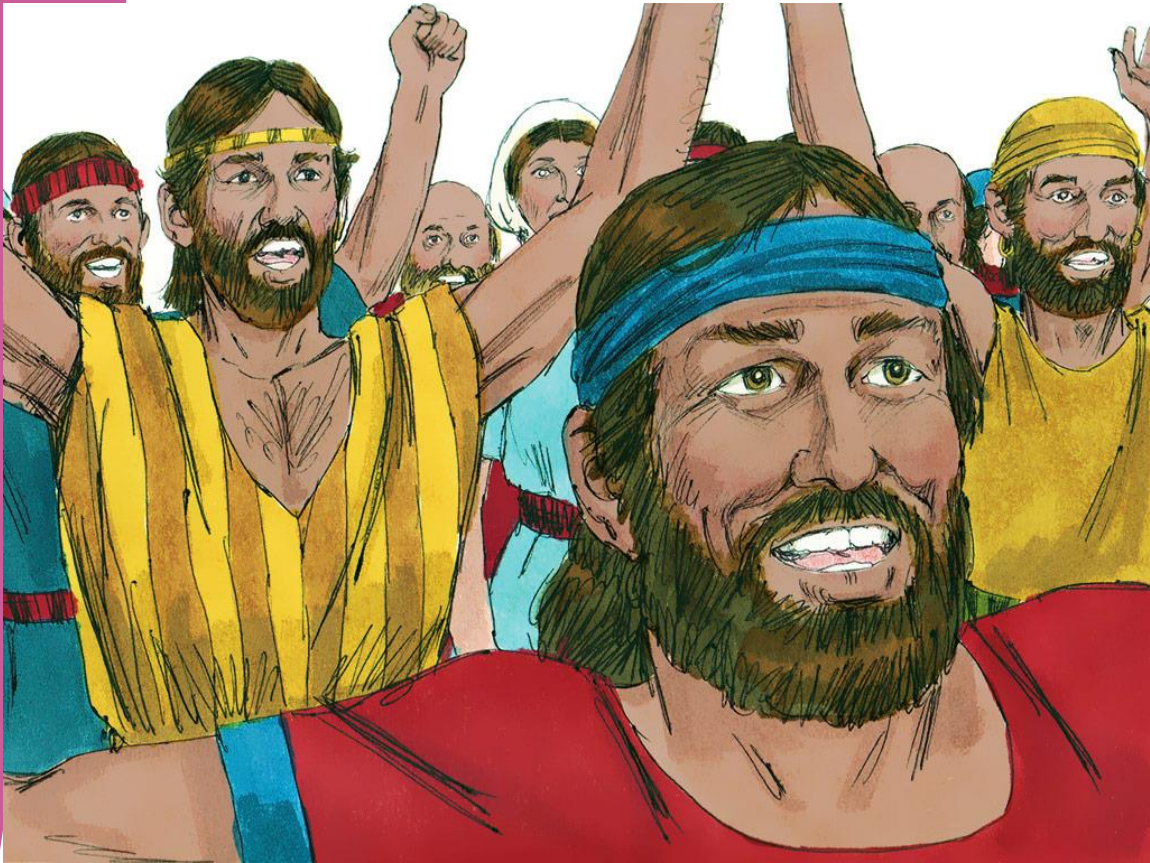
***Samuel calmed down

for HIS guidance.***



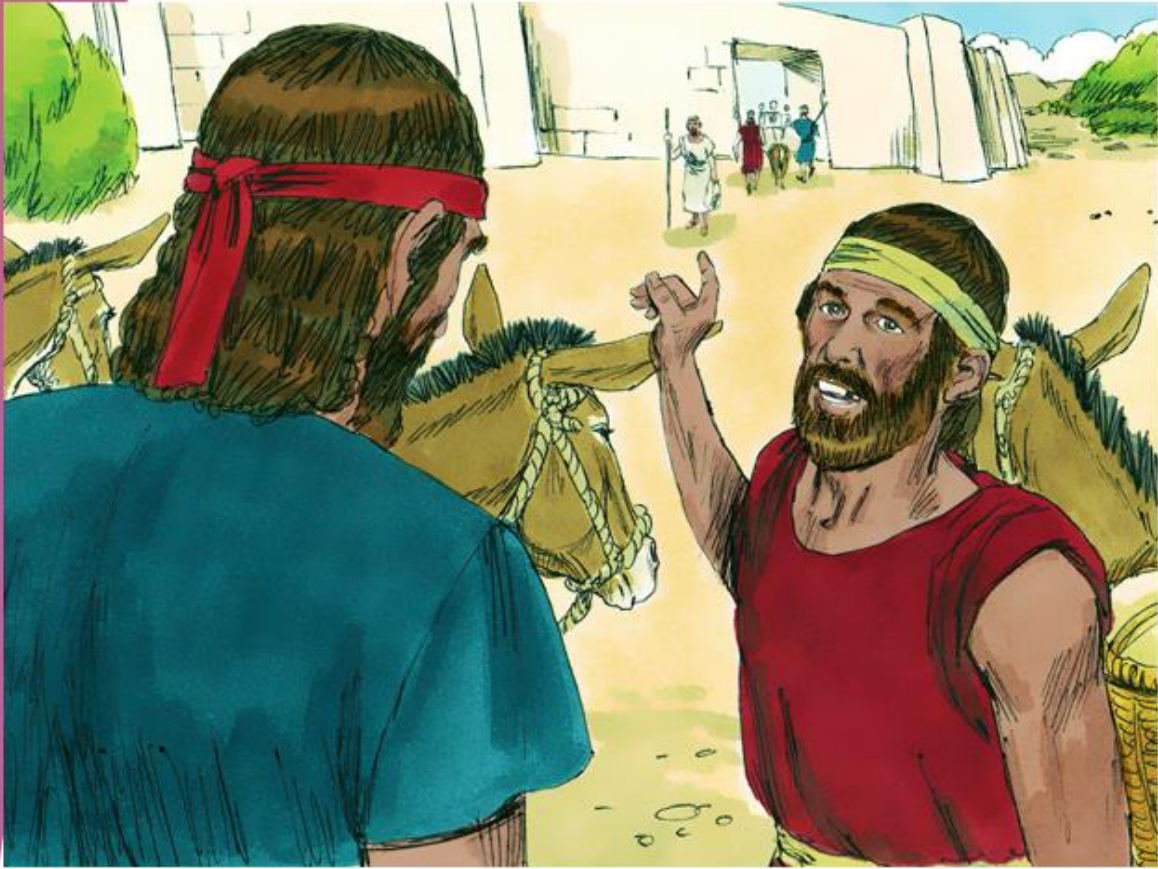
***GOD answered Samuel's
prayer. Let Israelites have king***



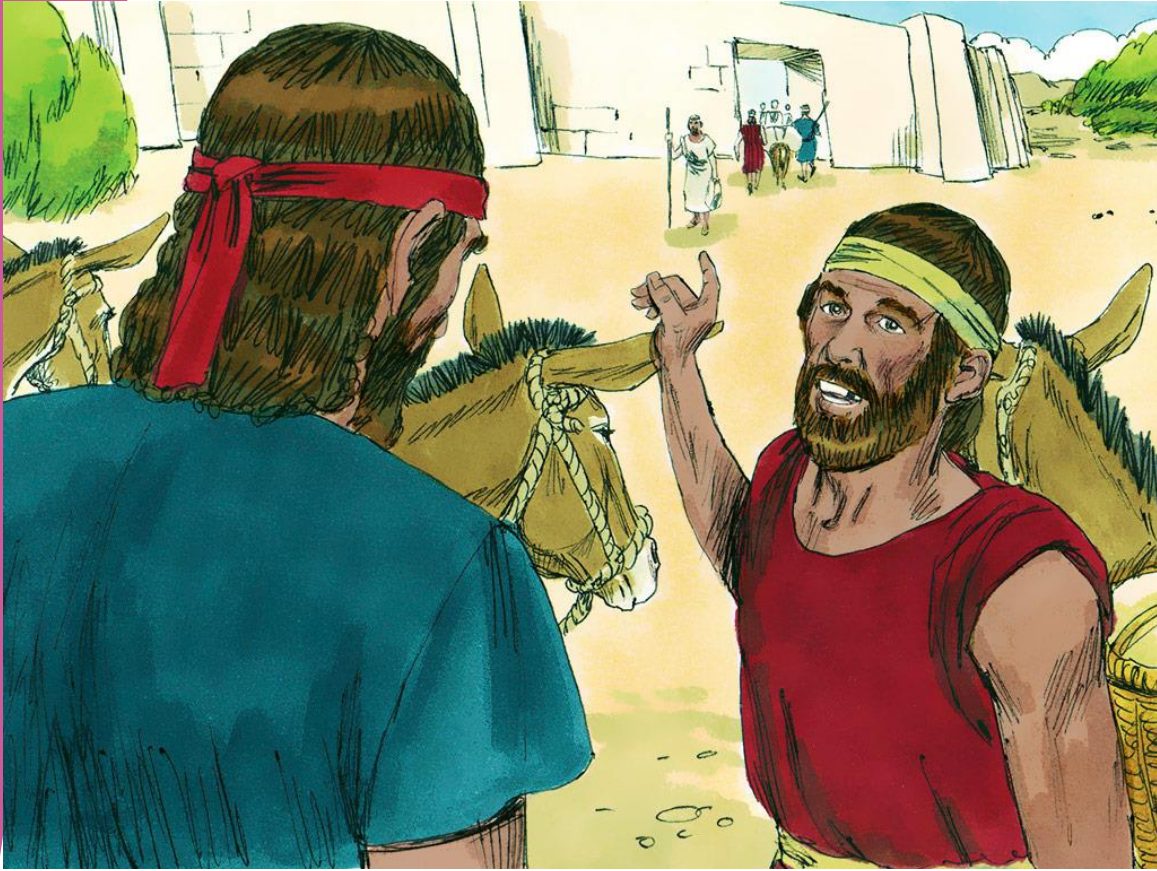
When Samuel heard all that the people said, he repeated it before the LORD.



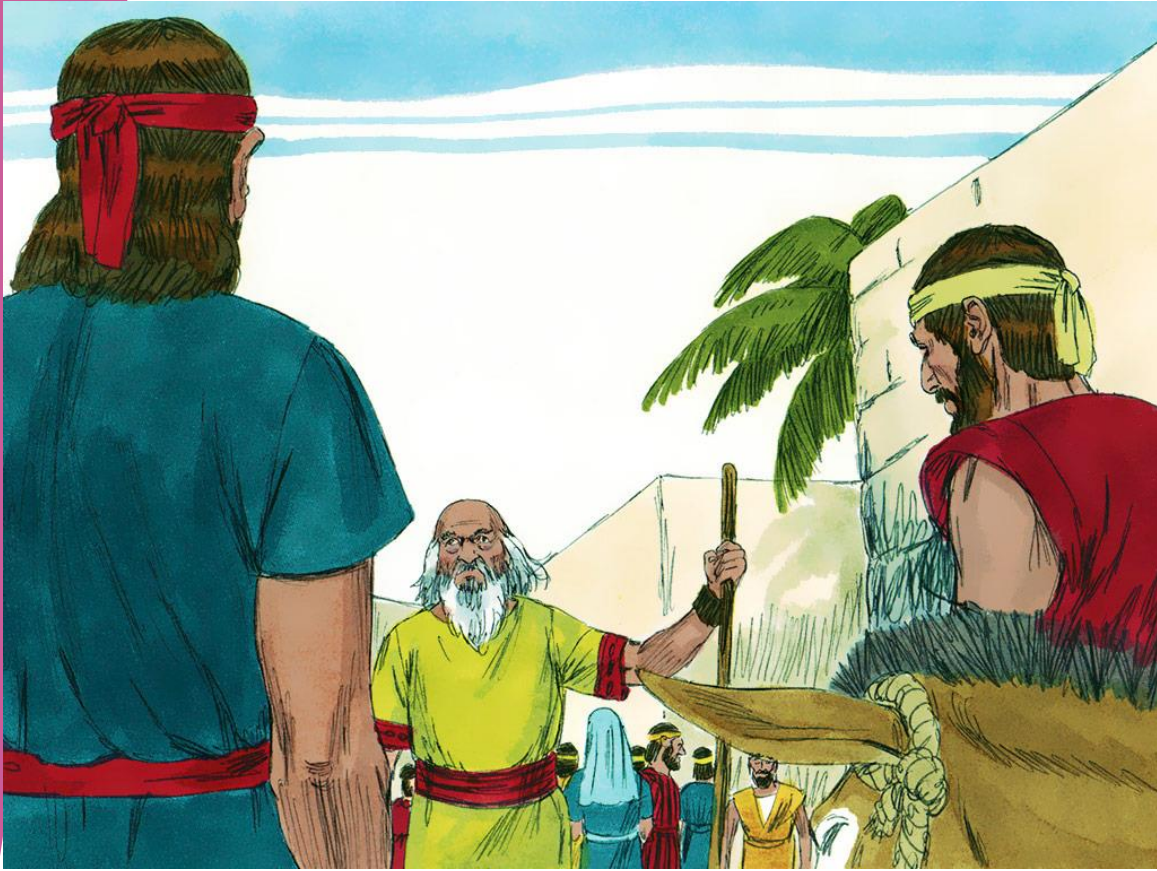
There was a Benjamite, a man of standing, whose name was Kish . Kish had a son named Saul



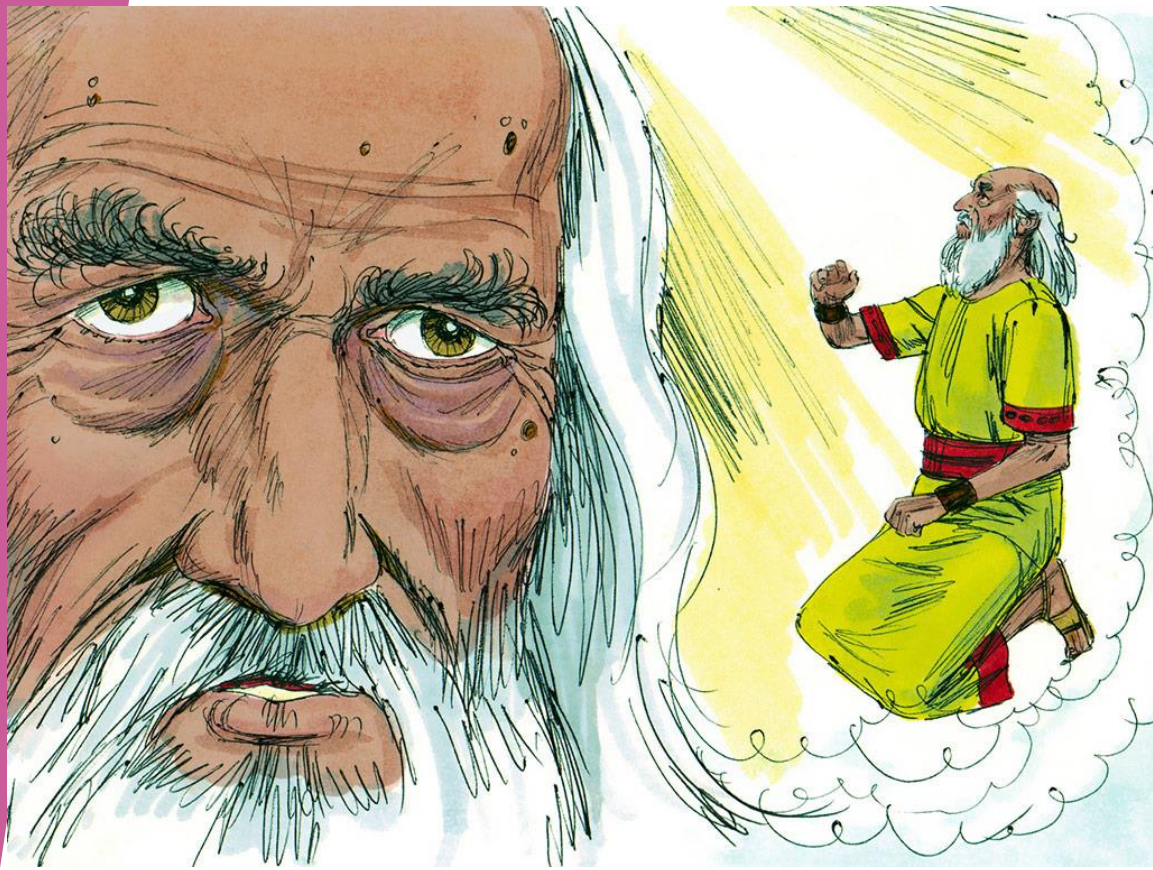
Now the donkeys belonging to Saul's father Kish were lost.



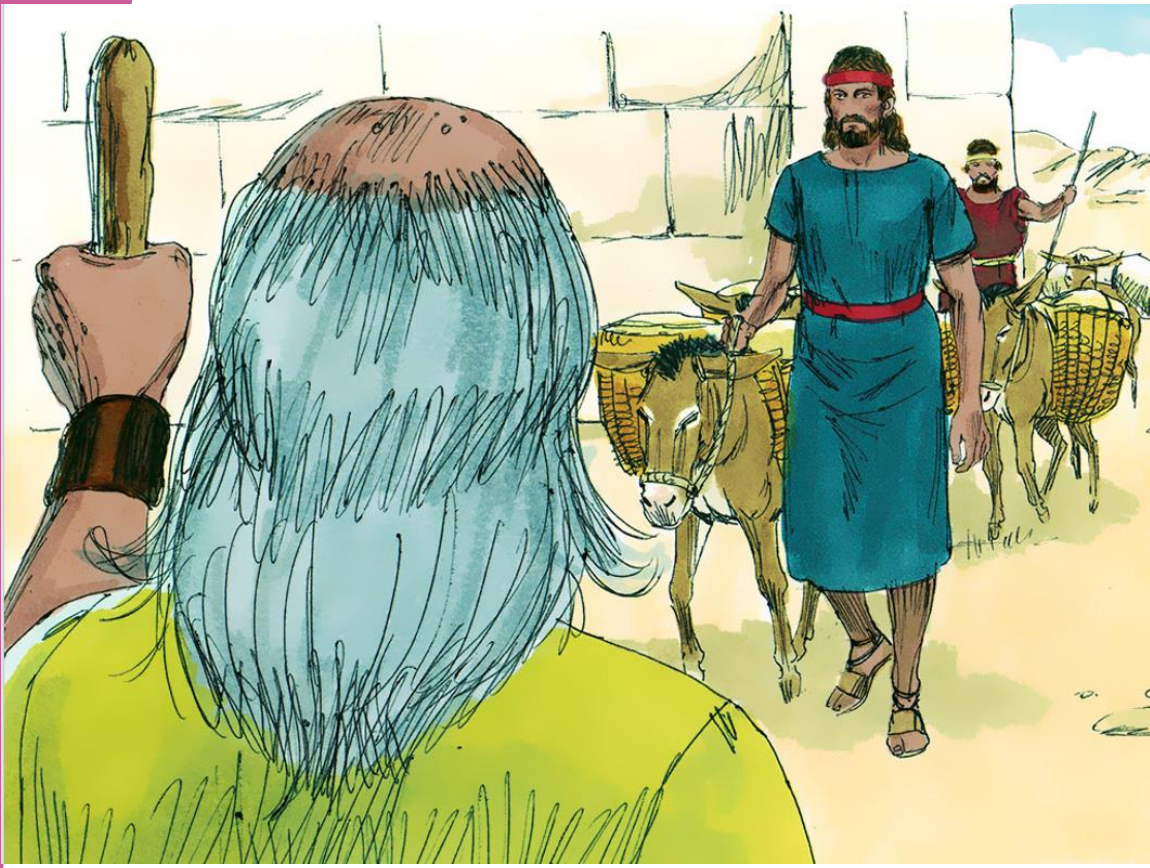
So he passed through the hill country of Ephraim and Shalisha, but they did not find them.



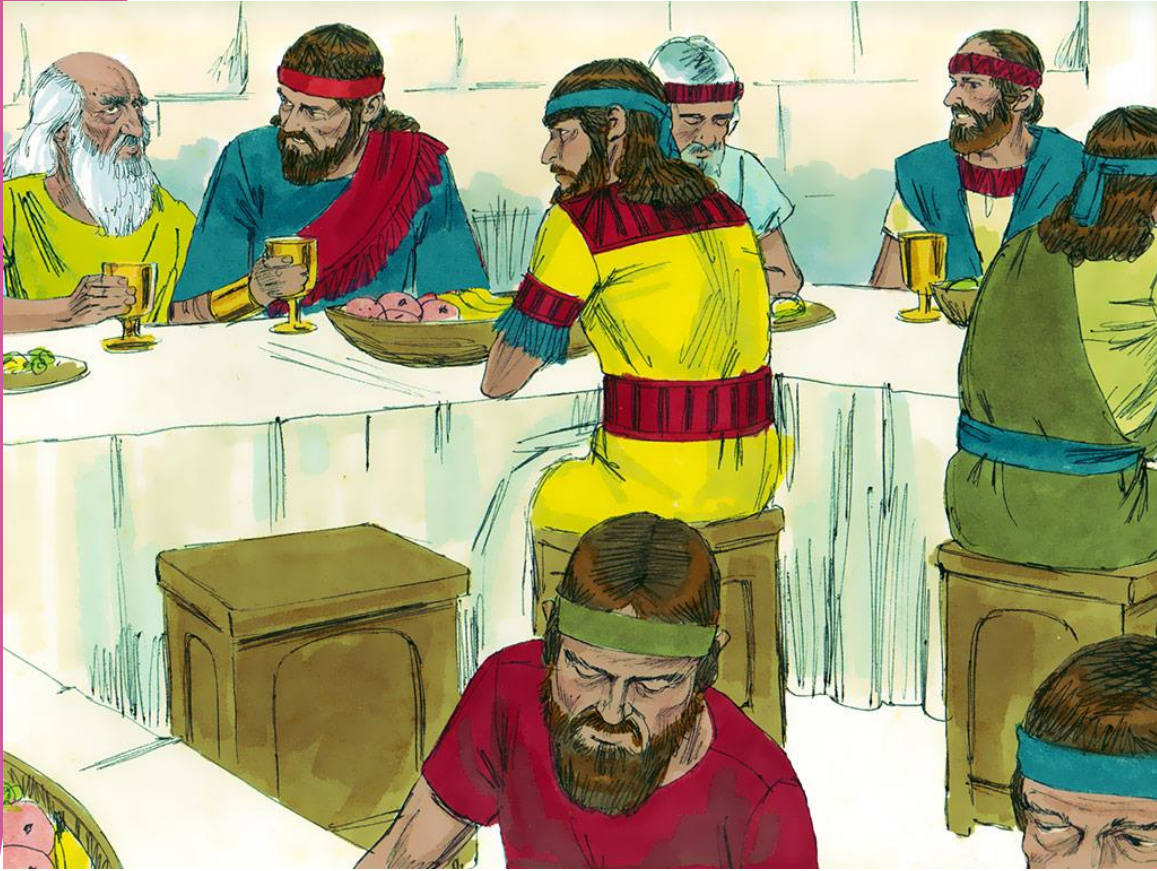

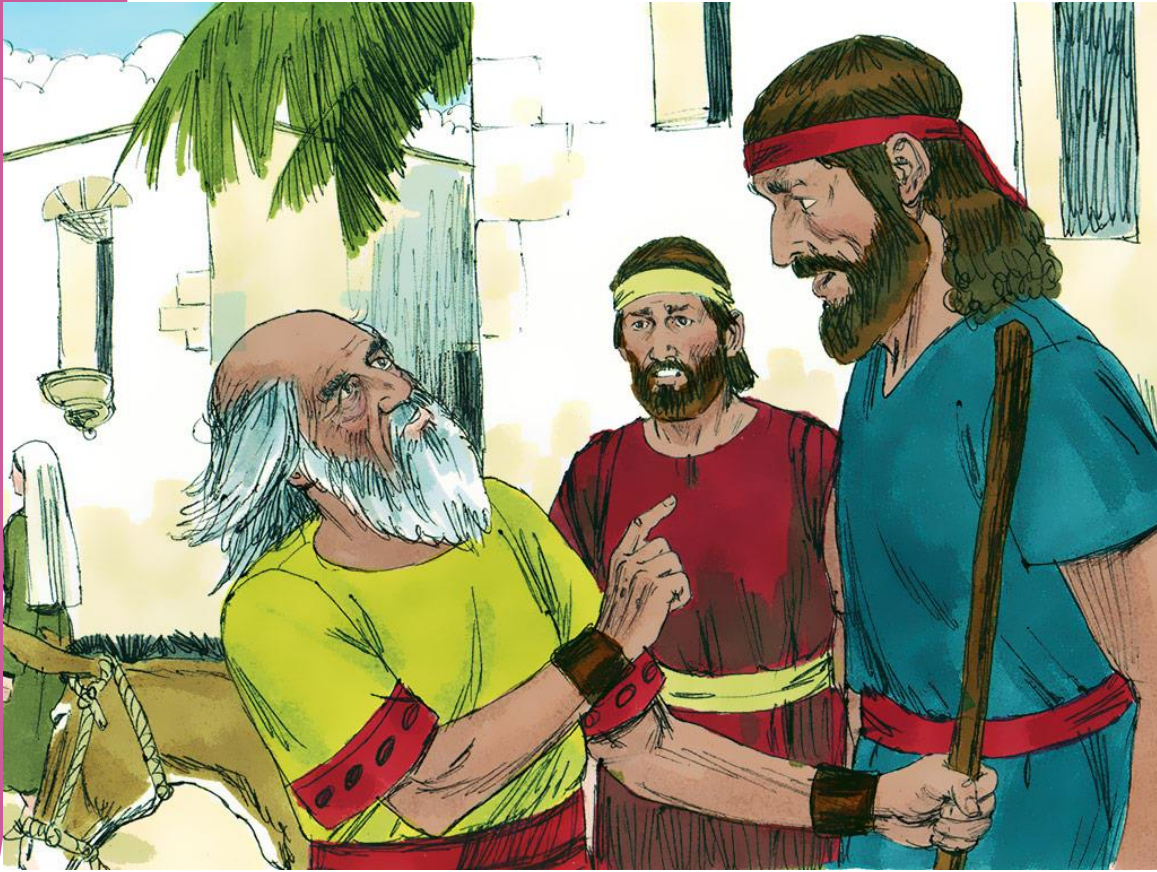

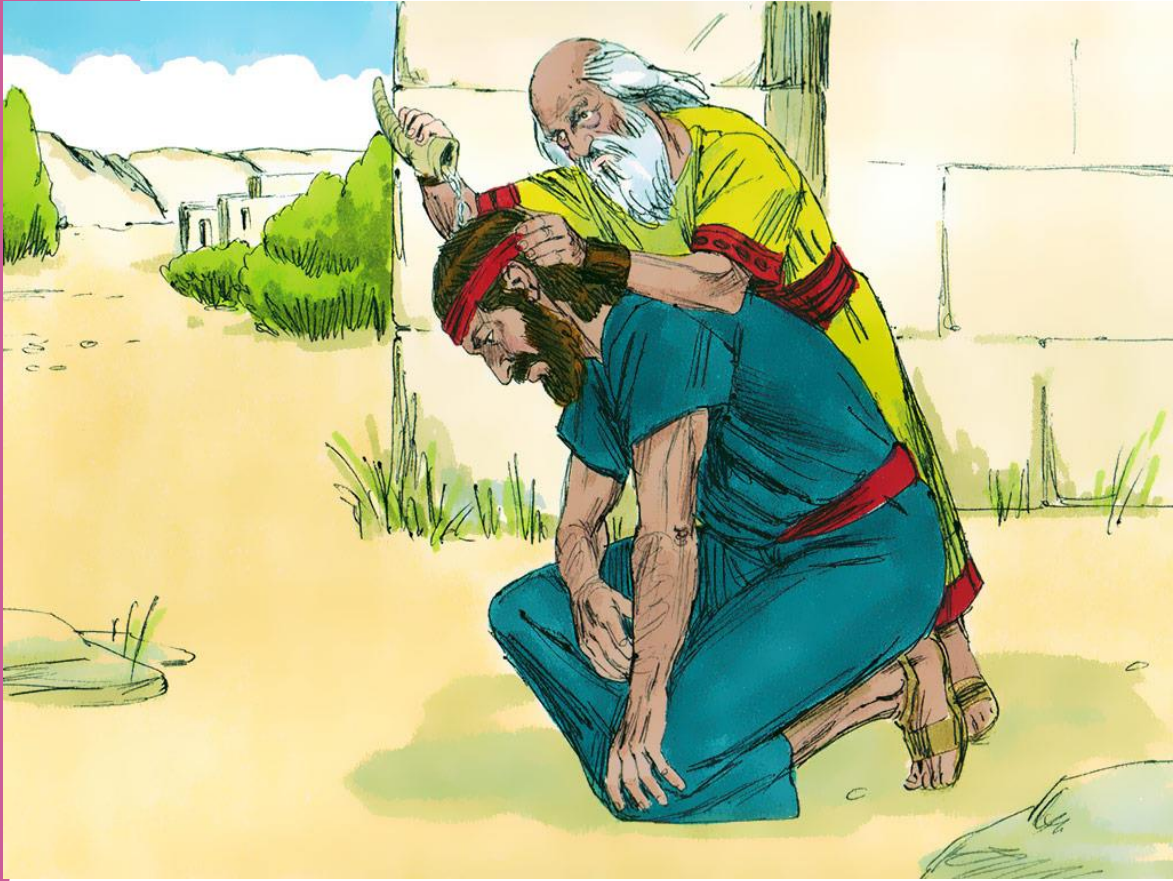
When Samuel caught sight of Saul, the LORD said to him, “This is the man I spoke to you about; he will govern my people.”



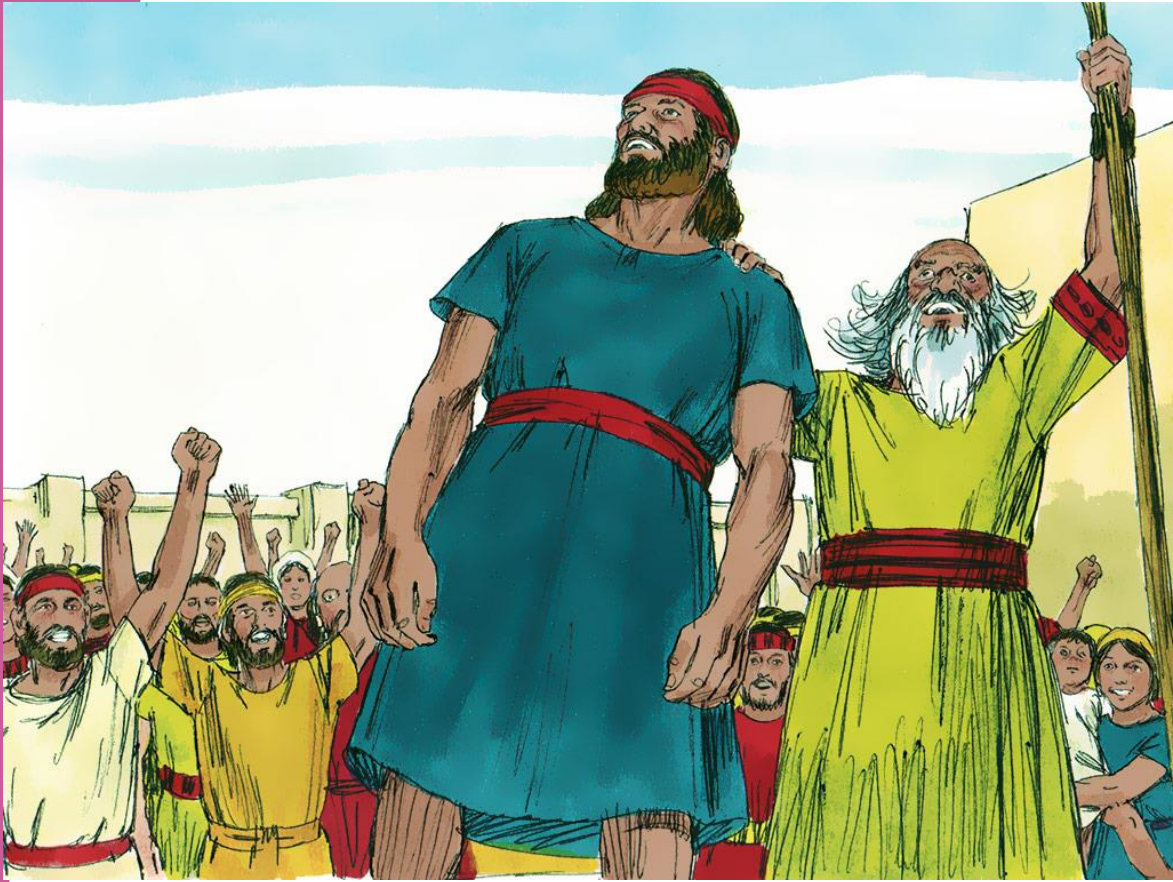
Samuel invited Saul and his servant for dine



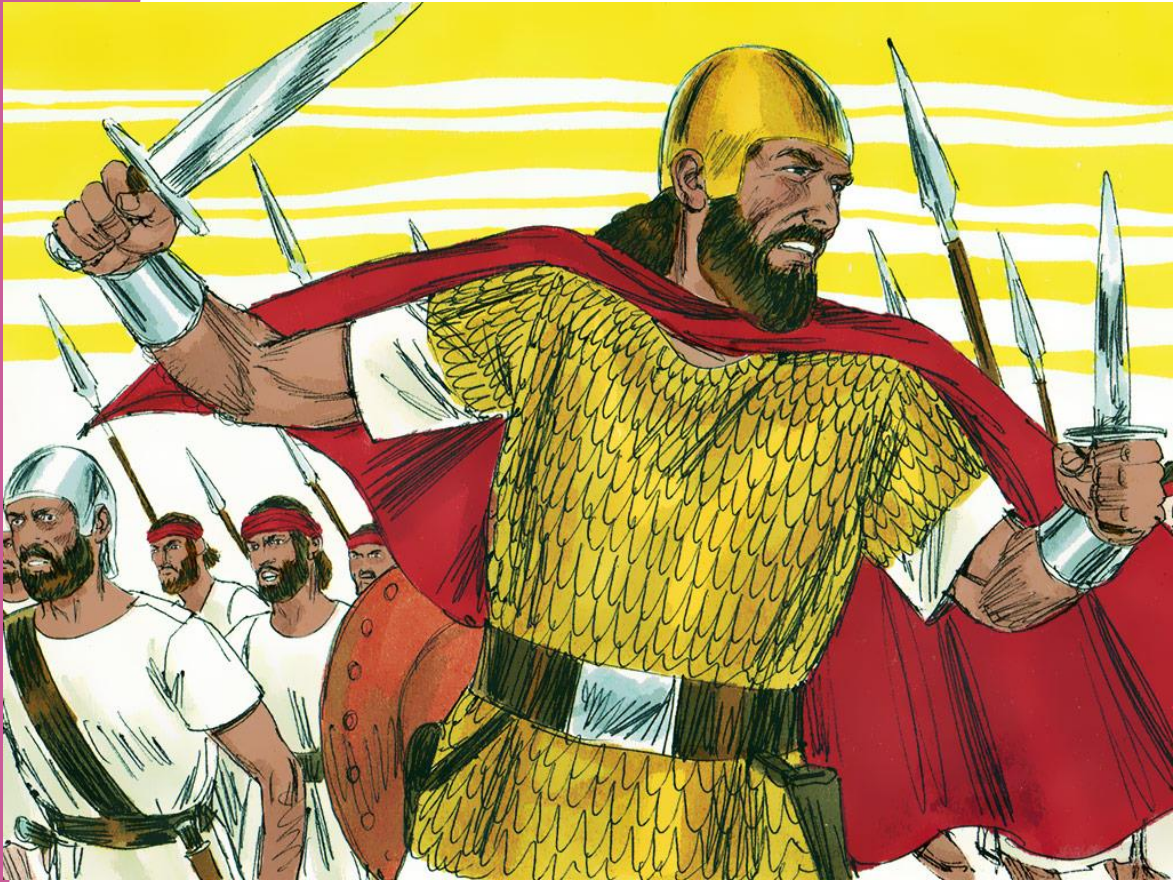
***Tell the servant to go on ahead of us”—and the servant did so—
“but you stay here for a while, so that I may give you a message from God.”***



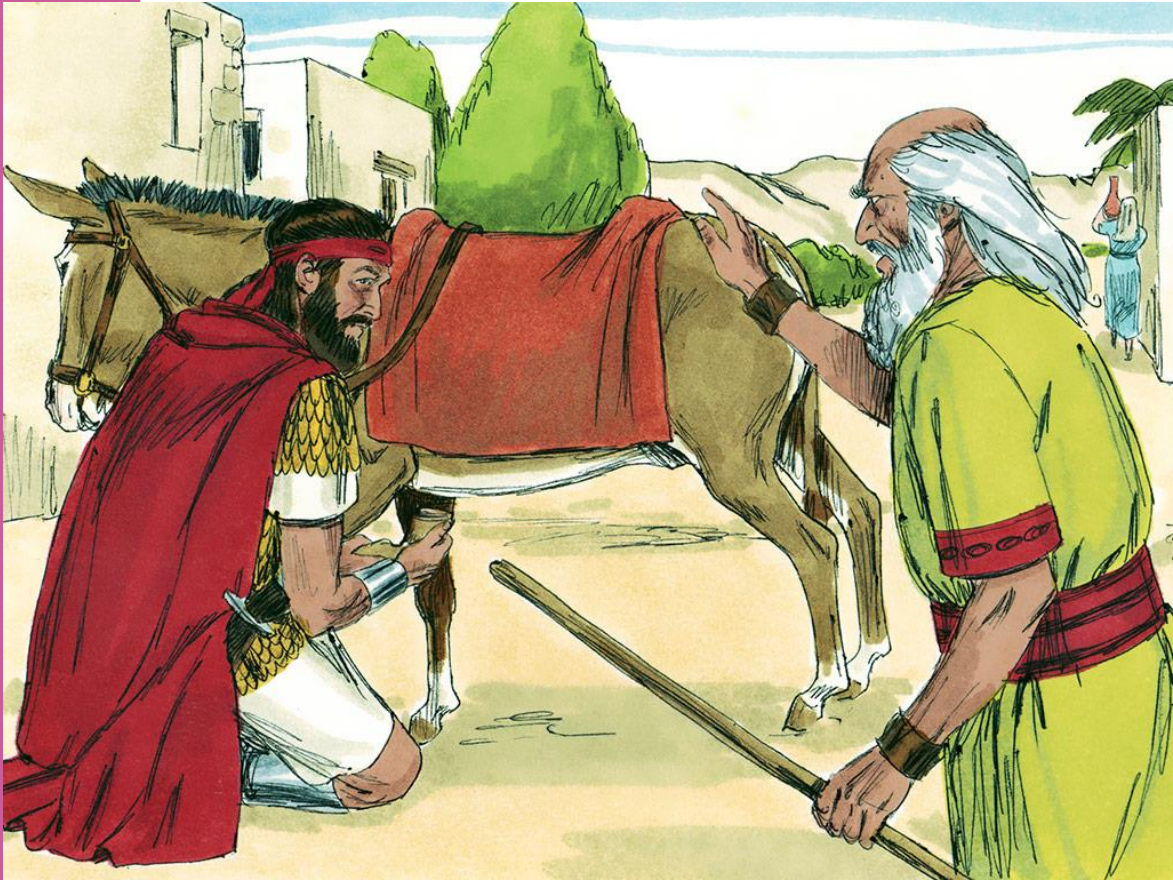
***Samuel anointed Saul became

GOD with Saul, every battle he led. He always win.



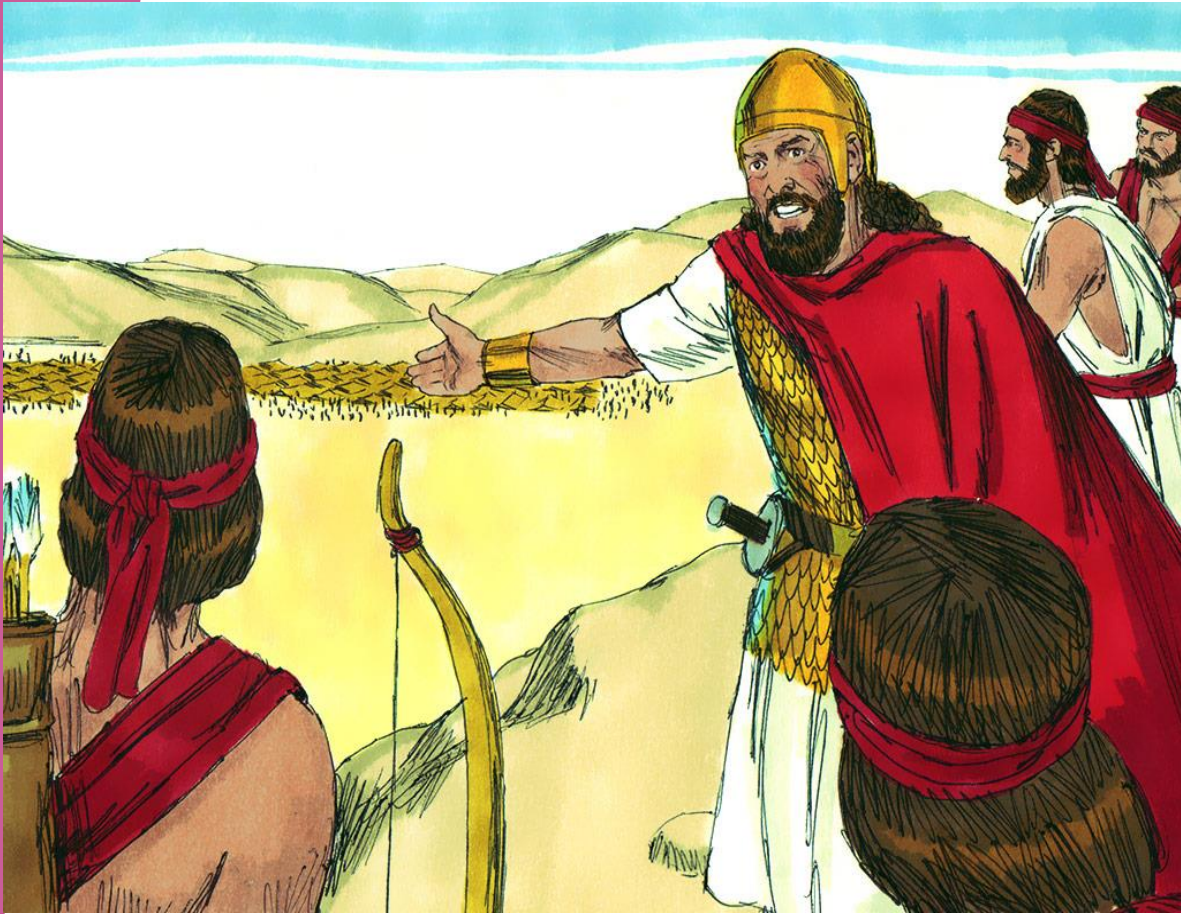
***Saul obey LORD's command. And
