







Jesus Heals a Man at Bethesda (John 5 : 1 - 18)



Jesus went up to Jerusalem for one of the Jewish festivals.




There is in Jerusalem near the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called Bethesda

One who was there had been an paralyze for 38 years.




When Jesus saw him lying there, Jesus said to him, "Do you want to be healed?




The man answered him, "Sir, I have no one to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up




Jesus said to him, "Get up, take up your bed, and walk."




And at once the man was healed, and he took up his bed and walked.




but Jews said to the man who had been healed, "It is the Sabbath, and it is not allow to take up your bed."




The man answered him, "Sir, They asked him, "Who is the man who said to you, 'Take up your bed and walk'?"




The man who had been healed did not know who Jesus was,



Afterward Jesus found him in the temple and said to him, "See, you are well! Sin no more,




"You shall have no other gods before me"




The man went away and told the Jewish leaders that it was Jesus who had made him well.
