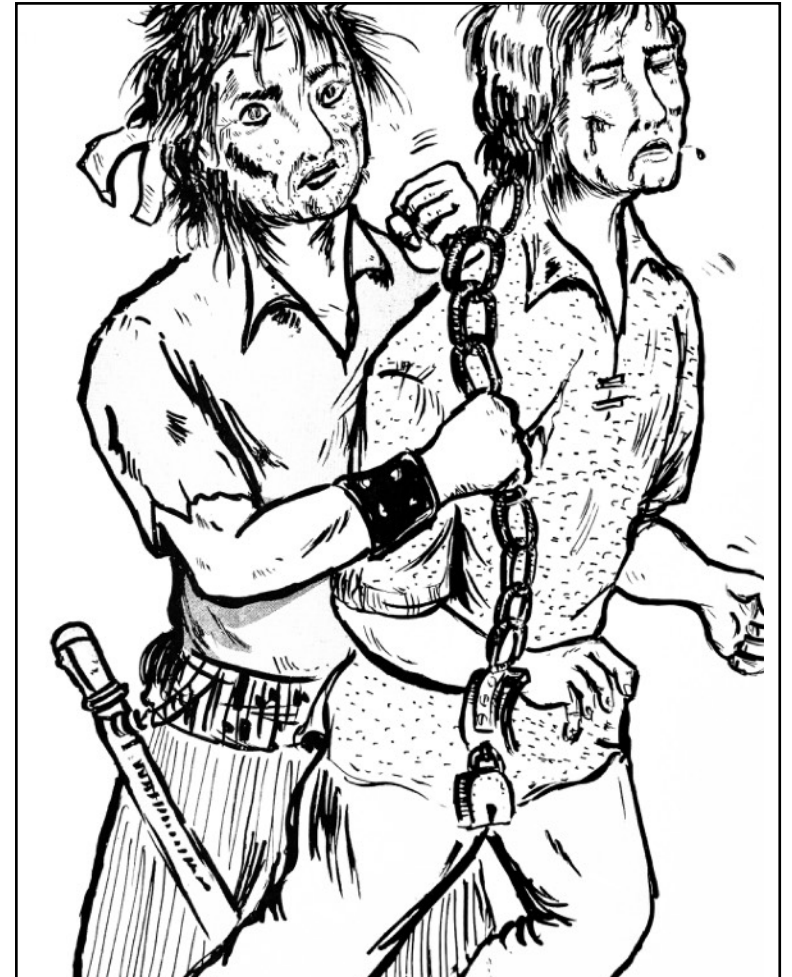




British army, who had conquered India, was challenged to war by the king of Burma, Bagi Daw.
