


Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people




Many parents bring their Children, even some were bringing even infants to him that he might touch them. And when the disciples saw it, they rebuked them




But Jesus called them to him, saying, "Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs **the kingdom of God.**

John Newton prayed as he'd never prayed before. He didn't feel able to call God 'Father', he knew something

Eventually the ship arrived safely in Ireland. It was while it was there being refitted that John became convinced that he had put his trust in the Lord Jesus Christ and become a Christian. In May 1748 he arrived back in England.



A Young man named Timothy






your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well.

One day Apostle Paul come to Listra to preach Gospel and meet with Timothy




Apostle Paul asked Timothy to go with him to preach Gospel and Paul taught
Timothy about scripture




Timothy follow Paul to many cities to preach gospel, ex : Macedonia, Ephesian, Philippian, Berea, etc
